- 3. From September 2nd to September 6th train to be able to talk about your choice to your class: be ready for a long turn of at least 1 minute 30 seconds and have 3 questions prepared to interview your classmates.

Prepare your oral presentation of the open letter. Take a few notes to remember what you want to say.

st 3. A reference such as a film, a photo, a book, a song, another article, etc that you want to relate with the chosen open letter
